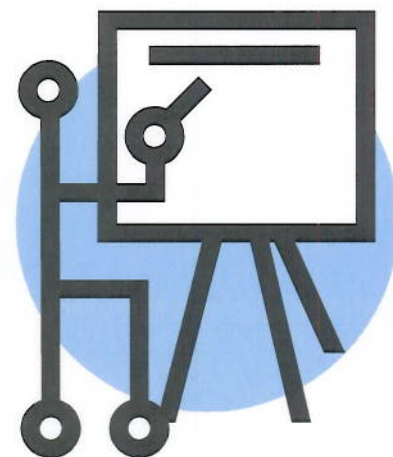
APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS

President's Message

PLAYING BETTER GOLF

If you are a typical club player, you probably have two wedges in your bag. Some club players carry only one wedge, and this is a mistake. Most professionals carry at least three wedges to give them the wide range of options they need for accurate approach play. In order to fit an extra wedge or two into the 14 clubs you

are allowed to carry, you can afford to give up a five-wood or a two-iron. As a result, you'll shave strokes by landing the ball closer to the hole on shots from the fairway, rough or sand.

Golf etiquette requires you to rake the sand before exiting a bunker. A sand trap or bunker should be left exactly

as you found it, and the same goes for greens and fairways. Divots should always be replaced and ball marks repaired. Erase all footprints in the sand traps. If you respect the course, then you respect the game; and if you respect the game, chance are you'll play better, too.
